


LOUIS JADOT CÔTE D'OR BURGUNDIES

Youthfully salty and initially bound up on the nose, conveying a slightly high-toned character, but aeration brought pure, high-pitched aromas of redcurrant, raspberry, blood orange, pepper, mint and menthol plus a vibrant element of crushed stone. Juicy, leanish and quite youthfully tight, but with captivating inner-mouth perfume and precision.
