After building this experience in the wine industry, he returned to Burgundy in 2014 to work for Maison Louis Jadot as the Deputy General Manager. He has since taken an interest in returning to the US for Louis Jadot's latest project, Résonance, located in the Yamhill-Carlton Valley of Oregon.
