

LOUIS JADOT CÔTE D'OR BURGUNDIES

Chambertin-Clos-de-Bèze Grand Cru 2024

A unique wine from this challenging vintage. Savory, deep and subtle, with aromas of iron, grilled oranges, blood oranges, licorice and spices. Light in form but full-bodied in tension and texture, and the wine is seamless with a minerally texture and an incredibly refined finish that lasts over a minute. So good. One of the best wines I've had from 2024. Drinkable now, but will be much better in the next six to 10 years.
