Résonance Vineyard Pinot Noir 2022

Coming from own-rooted vines planted in 1981 in Yamhill-Carlton, the 2022 Pinot Noir Resonance Vineyard offers wonderfully layered notes of crushed fresh cherries, pine spice, sweet herbs, and forest earth. Aged for 18 months in 30% new French oak barrels and revealing a touch more body, it's medium-framed, with ripe tannins and a light umami undertone, although it's lovely and pure throughout. A very well-styled wine with good structure, it's going to be worth snapping up from Jadot's Resonance Estate, which is led by Guillaume Large. Drink 2024-2040.
