

LOUIS JADOT CÔTE D'OR BURGUNDIES

Meursault Genevrières Premier Cru 2024

91-93 Points

The 2024 Meursault Les Genevrières 1er Cru has a refined bouquet with orchard fruit, grilled almonds and touches of mint, all well defined although not as intense as its peers. The palate is well balanced with tangerine and grapefruit on the entry, slightly honeyed in texture (bizarrely, almost as if there was a bit of noble botrytis—Barnier remarked that it is the ripest of the Meursault) leading to a rich but satisfying finish that is akin to a



Meursault-Charmes. Fascinating and it should age well in bottle.
