



LOUIS JADOT CÔTE D'OR BURGUNDIES

Clos Vougeot Grand Cru 2024

92-93 Points

From one of the sites that suffered the most from mildew in this growing season, the 2024 Clos Vougeot Grand Cru (Domaine Louis Jadot) represents only 3.5 barrels produced from two hectares. The crop of the bottom part of the clos, indeed, was almost entirely wiped out, so this bottling is dominated by Jadot's holdings higher up the slope. Offering up notes of plums, orange zest, root beer and cola, it's medium- to full-



bodied, fleshy and dense, with a thick,
layered profile that reflects the low yields.
