Roure Crozes-Hermitage Blanc 2024

All Marsanne from slopes with deep soils of white earth and loess, the 2024 Crozes-Hermitage Domaine De Roure Blanc is aged in concrete eggs and demi-muids. Bright citrus, honeyed lemon, salty minerality, and white flowers define the aromatics, and it's medium-bodied, very fresh, focused, and steely on the palate. It has bright acidity, obvious minerality, and outstanding length, cutting a very fine line where other wines show more breadth. Give it a year of bottle age and drink over the following 4-5 years. Drink 2027-2032.



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
