

ZIND-HUMBRECHT

Pinot Gris Roche Volcanique 2019

This wine smells like autumn. Intense aromas of apple and freshly cut oak rise from the glass. On the palate, baking apples are tempered by a pleasantly bitter, stemmy edge. Cinnamon and vanilla close out on a long finish. This is a great example of oak being present and vibrant but not dominating an otherwise delicate wine. Pair it with poultry, a stew or just a wood fire for the ambience.
