The 2011 Champagne Blanc de Blancs
Comte de Champagne is from all the Grand
Crus of the Côte de Blancs except for Oiry.
With a kiss of toasted brioche, caramel
apple, and a hint of saline, this wine gets
more savory as it opens, although it has a
bit of greenness. The palate is full, with a
fine mousse and a dusty feel of chalk, as
well as fresh and pithy citrus. It has a
reasonably long finish, although perhaps
not up to par for the tête de cuvée. It is
drinking well now but is likely best for
relatively early drinking. 2022-2033.
