Pouilly-Fuissé Clos des  
Prouges 2023

The 2023 Pouilly-Fuissé Tête de Cru Clos des Prouges comes from a vineyard planted with 76-year-old vines and was raised with 25% new oak. It opens with a blossom-tinged nose, followed by ripe and honeyed fruit, especially nectarine. On the palate, the wine is immediately round and voluminous, with a creamy texture that fills the mouth before narrowing along the mid-palate, tightened by the emergence of its underlying powdery throughline. The finish is long and persistent, leaving a flavorful hazelnut-tinged impression.
