

LOUIS JADOT CÔTE D'OR BURGUNDIES

Corton-Grèves Grand Cru 2018

Here the nose is quite timid and only grudgingly reveals its ripe, sauvage and earthy aromas of black pinot fruit and discreet wood influences. There is good volume to the solidly punchy bigbodied flavors that is quite supple on the midpalate which contrasts significantly with the savory and moderately grippy, compact and very firm finale. This rustic and overtly powerful effort is classic old school Corton in style.
